Ministry of Transport, Bonn Climate Change Talks

The side event is dedicated to technically sound and **politically acceptable levies on emissions from** international aviation and **maritime transport**. Applied worldwide, collected centrally, they **would raise \$10bn+ annually for climate** adaptation, REDD+, and technology.

Why is it Important?

- Levies are proposed for negotiations within AWGLCA (paragraphs 36, and 173d)
 - > 173. New and additional resources {shall} be generated through ...
 - (d) Levies on emissions from international aviation (and maritime transport)
- Shipping levy, which recognizes national circumstances, is viable
 - Already endorsed by several countries and organizations
- You could help to galvanize negotiations for an equitable financing from 2013
